ACTIVE MEMBERS – ROTH PLAN CHANGES

If you would like to change, begin or end contributions to the Roth Plan, you must sign a form and return to Melissa Del Prete in the Benefits Office by Monday, October 18, 2017.

You must meet this deadline in order to have the change you are electing effective with your employer by the first pay period of November. If you neglect the deadline, you will not be eligible to change again until May 2018. Please contact Melissa Del Prete at 585-338-2310 x107 with questions.

ACTIVE MEMBERS ON THE EXCELLUS HEALTH PLAN

It is **VERY IMPORTANT** that the Fund Office is notified if you have a baby. **You MUST complete an enrollment form within 30 days of the date of birth** in order to ensure your child has coverage. If you fail to enroll your child within 30 days, your child may be ineligible for coverage until the next Open Enrollment period. Please contact Tricia Marciano at 585-338-2310 x106 regarding any enrollment issues.

CHECK RECIPIENTS

If you receive a check from the Benefit Office for any reason, a Pension payment, a Disability Payment, an hour bank reimbursement, or a recently issued Health Screening incentive check and it is not cashed within 6 months, it will no longer be honored by the Bank and another check WILL NOT be reissued. We encourage you to cash your checks promptly.

HEALTH INSURANCE RE-ENROLLMENT: URGENT NOTICE

If you become ineligible for health insurance, then you return to work, IT IS YOUR responsibility to contact the benefit office and re-enroll on the Health Plan. If you would like to re-enroll on the Insurance Plan, please contact Tricia Marciano at 585-338-2310 x106 for details.

PENSIONERS

We have received phone calls that members have not received their Pension Check on the 1st of the month. The Benefit Office mails all checks in a timely fashion, yet the only way to ensure a 1st of the month payment is to enroll for Direct Deposit. ANNUITY

The Guaranteed Income Fund has a guaranteed interest rate of 1.65% **effective July 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017**. The interest rate will not fluctuate during this time.

ANNUITY - MEMBERS PARTICIPATING IN THE LOAN PROGRAM

If you are participating in the loan program and receive a letter from Prudential, it is imperative that you read all notices as it may be regarding a potential default on your loan. You need to adhere to all dates and instructions in the letter to avoid default. Prudential automatically defaults members if you are more than 90 days behind your payment date, yet you will receive 3 notices prior to default. It is extremely important you stay timely with payments. Once your loan is automatically defaulted, it is difficult to reverse. If you make payments after default, they will not be returned, as they are considered Plan Assets. If you have questions regarding your loan, please contact Prudential at 1-877-778-2100 and refer to Plan number 767002. You will need to reference your social security number and loan number or contact Melissa Del Prete in the Local 13 Benefit Office at 585-338-2310 x107.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THE AFFORDABLE CARE ACT

According to Federal Law, if you terminate your Health Insurance Policy with Local 13, you may be subject to a penalty if you don't enroll in another Health Care Plan that provides minimum value. APPRENTICES: Reminder to fill out your **BLUE BOOKS** daily and to have your Foreman sign them. **We need a copy of your blue book MONTHLY**, due by the end of each month. Blue Books are a NYS DOL requirement and are YOUR responsibility. Monitoring dates: Monday, October 23rd through Thursday, October 26th.

WELDING: Open welding is Monday and Wednesday nights from 5:00 p.m. – 8:30 p.m. and Saturday mornings from 7:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. **Continuity is the WELDER'S responsibility**; if you lapse, you must re-test. We have continuity on the odd numbered months before the Union Meetings. There will be a weld test scheduled on the last Saturday of every month throughout the school year. You must receive approval and sign up for the weld test prior to the test date.

COURSE REIMBURSEMENT FOR OUTSIDE TRAINING: Course Applications must be submitted by member two (2) weeks prior to course date, and must be approved by the JATC Board prior to reimbursement. Applications are available on our website: www.ualocal13.org. All applications must have back up paper work explaining the courses, fees, etc.
