INSURANCE FUND NEWS

Active Members on Local 13 Health Insurance

You will be receiving new ID cards as of January 1, 2024, however there are no changes to the Plan Benefits.

Insurance Hour Requirement—Active Members

Your insurance coverage is determined every quarter, and it is based on the hours you work. Single coverage requirement is 360 hours and Family coverage is 430 hours per quarter. If you do not have excess funds in your Hour Bank, you will receive a bill for the hours you are short. The bill is sent by mail and e-mail. If the bill is not paid within 30 days, your coverage will be terminated. It is your responsibility to contact the Benefit Office to re-enroll once you earn the hours back in the following quarter. Please keep the Benefit Office updated with any address change as well as a current e-mail address. ANNUITY FUND NEWS

Effective January 1, 2023, the Annuity Joint Board of Trustees has voted to allow an "In Service Distribution/Withdrawal" to any active participant aged 59 1/2 or older. This is not a loan. It is a distribution or withdrawal from your account as a lump sum. **Empower must withhold a 20% federal tax** and you may elect a NYS voluntary tax upon withdrawal. **There is a mandatory 8 day waiting period for any distribution per IRS regulations**.

The Prudential Retirement app has been changed to Empower Prudential Retirement and is available to download through the App Store or through Google Play.

Empower's Service Center is available to assist members with questions regarding their Annuity accounts. Their phone number is 1-877-778-2100.

Please be advised that the Prudential Guaranteed Fund interest rate for the period **July 1, 2023** through **December 31, 2023 will be set at 1.95%.**

Please update your beneficiary forms. DO NOT PUT IT OFF!! It is imperative when life-changing events occur (i.e.: marriage, children, divorce). These forms are on our website in the Benefits Office section.
